1. Be at least 21 years of age.
2. Wear a bathing suit or costume at the plunge on Saturday, February 16, 2019
3. Ride on the throne of ice.
4. Take the Plunge.
5. Secure donations of money to donate to the Polar Bear Run Walk for Autism
6. Select a business or a community, civic, or other recognized organization for a sponsor. (optional)
7. Submit a signed application form.
8. Appear on Friday February 15, 2019 at 9 pm in costume under the tent at La Costa.
9. Participate in the Polar Bear Plunge on Saturday, February 16, 2019
10. Adhere to the Polar Bear King & Queen Conduct Code: Any contestant, family member or contestants guests showing less than acceptable behavior (during the pre and post-polar bear plunge) will lead to disqualification of the contestant.
11. You agree the judges' decisions are final.
12. The contestants raising the most pledges will be finalist.
13. If selected, you agree to abide by all the rules and regulations of the Polar Bear King & Queen Contest.
14. You will permit the Polar Bear Plunge Committee the right to use your photograph for publicity purposes.
15. Serve for one year only.
